Family and Domestic Violence Prevention:

A comprehensive training provided to a variety of audiences that covers family and domestic violence prevention. This training can be tailored to meet the needs of community members, workers in the field, administrators and tribal councils.

Building Healthy Relationships

Do you ever wonder where you got your relationships skills? Building Health Relationships helps answer that questions and a whole lot more. You will engage in a journey that takes you form how our characteristics are initiated and the key elements of their development onto our relationship attachments. From there, you will be given tools to help you identify relationship patterns so that you can maintain or build healthy relationships.

Bullying 101 for Parents, Guardians and Community members

So many children are bullied in society and not enough is done, until the situations become serious for action to be taken. ITCC has design this workshop to make everyone in the community aware of the signs of someone who is a victim of a bully. The workshop covers the different types of bullying, the cycle of a bully and how to break the cycle of a bully. This workshop provides facts and law pertaining to bullying. In addition this training covers how to teach prevention with Traditions and Culture. Interactive group activities though out the class.

Sexual Assault “No Healing In Silence”:

This is an interactive training/workshop that covers topics such as the signs and symptoms of child sexual abuse, boarding school experiences and the healing process for survivors of sexual assault. This training can be tailored to meet the needs of the community members, workers in the field, administrators, tribal councils and survivors of sexual abuse/sexual assault.

Tribal Law Enforcement Training:

This is a comprehensive training provided to State and Tribal police, specifically dealing with family and domestic violence on Tribal lands or in Tribal homes and communities. This training is very comprehensive and must be tailored to each specific community. Please meet with ITCC administration to identify the needs of your training.

Talking Circles – Facilitation & Development:

This is an ongoing training that helps in the leadership and development of the traditional practiced Talking Circle. Many issues can be brought to the table in the holistic approach that the talking circle brings. Each topic can be tailored to meet the different needs of the community. This training is offered to participants who want to facilitate their own talking circle, community members, and workers in the field, administrators and Tribal councils.

Coalition Building:

ITCC has been apart of coalition development for over 35 years. Collaboration with both ITCC and the California Attorney Generals Office of Native American Affairs in various county governments throughout California, and has been very successful. ITCC’s Tribal Coalition Development Coordinator works with service providers, local State and County and Tribal Governments. This training helps meet the needs of each specific area for development in California. This training is open to anyone wanting to further develop, create, and maintain a sustainable coalition.

Teen Dating Violence Prevention:

Teen Dating Violence is out there. Many communities are affected by this problem and have very little resources. ITCC has taken on this problem head on, with a zero tolerance approach. This training is tailored to meet the needs of each community or group in which ITCC serves. Not only does this training encompass Federal and State approved guidelines, but also the ideas and concerns of Tribal youth in California. This training can be tailored to meet the needs of community members, workers in the field, administrators and Tribal councils.

Effective Tribal and Client Advocacy:

Many times in social services, clients are forced to follow strict guidelines and regulations in order to receive services. Without the appropriate advocate helping each client through this strenuous process, clients can often feel re-victimized or lost in this process. ITCC strives to meet the needs of everyone that is served. This training was developed to help providers take all situations for a client into account. Showing clients the basic steps they need in order to receive all the services that are provided for them.

Substance Abuse Prevention and Education:

Substance abuse is a plague that reaches many communities throughout the nation. Unfortunately some of the highest percentages of substance abuse are within the Native American populations. ITCC has a number of employees that are certified Drug and Chemical Dependency Counselors. Not only does ITCC provide the mandated training guidelines for substance abuse, but also a holistic traditional approach for tribal people. This training can be tailored to meet the needs of community members, workers in the field, administrators and tribal councils.

C.R.A.D.L.E.B.O.A.R.D. Way:

This training/workshop meets the needs of any tribal entity in the United States by one common Native American tradition, the CRADELEBOARD. This training initiates self-awareness, promotes individual responsibilities, develops social order in the community, and inspires morality, consciousness, forgiveness and generosity. By the use of prayer gathering of materials for the basket, design of the basket, construction of the basket and tribal modeling of the basket responsibilities and skills are demonstrated. This training can be tailored to meet the needs of community members, workers in the field, administrators and tribal councils.

Collaborative Leadership Skills Workshop:

ITCC has been apart of collaborative development for over 35 years. ITCC's Tribal Coalition Development Coordinator works with service providers, local State, County and Tribal Governments. This training helps meet the needs of each specific area for development in California. This training is open to anyone wanting to further develop, create, and maintain a sustainable coalition.

Protocol Development:

ITCC has been reported by the Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Violence Against Women Office as one of the top five lead agencies for protocol development in the nation specific to OJP in 2002. With over 35 years of experience in protocol development ITCC has created various protocols for Federal and State programs, as well as Tribal governments. These guidelines and protocols are reviewed and revised on an ongoing basis to keep up with ongoing changes in legislation as well as Tribal law and governments.

Early Childhood Development and Education – Parent Ed.:

ITCC provides a number of services to parents and services providers. Early childhood development and education in Tribal communities is very important for the future success of Tribal governments, nutrition, literacy and life skills to promote proper growth and development for Tribal youth and families. This training can be tailored to meet the needs of community members, workers in the field, administrators and Tribal councils.

Childhood Trauma Education and Prevention:

This training deals with youth that are faced with family and domestic violence in their homes or communities from ages 0 to 18. Often times, children are overlooked in domestic violence situations, until later showing signs of being traumatized. This training can be tailored to meet the needs of community members, workers in the field, administrators and Tribal councils.

Program Compliance:

ITCC operates over 18 Federal, State, County and private programs and administrations. Each entity complies with guidelines set by each governing unit. With 35 years of successful administration ITCC provides program compliance training, specifically tailored to meet requirements specified on each grant, legislation and or law.

Strength Based Youth Development:

ITCC operates three Federal and State funded youth development programs. These programs together have created the California Tribal Youth Wellness Initiative. With this initiative ITCC has created a strength based youth development training that encompasses the unique needs of Tribal youth as well as obstacles and barriers our youth face today. The wellness program brings a positive aspect to youth training as opposed to traditional punitive approaches. This training can be tailored to meet the needs of community members, workers in the field, and administrators and Tribal councils.

Governance Development/Board Training:

ITCC has been in a governance capacity for 35 years. This training is geared for Tribal governments and boards on issues facing Tribal communities today. There are many different levels of this training for new boards and governments to entities that have been in existence for many years. Please meet with ITCC administrators for more details on this training to meet the specific needs of your training.

Events Planning:

ITCC provides conference, trainings, workshops and classes on a regular routine basis with many years outstanding success. This training can be tailored to meet the needs of community members, workers in the field, administrators and Tribal councils.
